

New Rules for signatures on '**Minor Release and Waiver**' forms

Due to new Insurance requirements relating to minor participants, there have been restrictions placed on how a Minor Release and Waiver form may be accepted.

If the participant will be under 18 years old on the day before the event, an **AMA Minor Recreation Release and Waiver** form must be presented on site at registration check-in and **signed** as follows:

IMPORTANT: *Both parents must sign the waiver in front of the witness at registration check-in. If both parents cannot be present at check-in, then the release form must be signed by both parents and Notarized off-site prior to check-in.*

A single parent, who indicates they have SOLE LEGAL CUSTODY or are the SOLE PARENT, may ONLY sign the waiver in front of the witness at registration check-in. (A notarized waiver signed by a single parent will not be accepted)

A GUARDIAN cannot sign for a Minor participant. There can be NO Exceptions!
