

## New Rules for signatures on ‘Minor Release and Waiver’ forms

Due to new Insurance requirements relating to minor participants, there have been restrictions placed on how a Minor Release and Waiver form may be accepted.

If the participant will be under 18 years old on the day before the event, an **AMA Minor Recreation Release and Waiver** form must be presented on site at registration check-in and **signed** as follows:

**LEGAL GUARDIANS:** *Must present a copy of Official Court documents naming the Legal Guardians.*

*Both parents/guardians must sign the AMA Minor Release form in front of the witness at registration check-in. If both parents/guardians cannot be present at check-in, then the AMA Minor Release form must be signed by both parents/guardians and Notarized off-site prior to check-in, and then presented at registration check-in by at least one of the parents/guardians.*

*A **SINGLE PARENT**, who indicates they have **SOLE LEGAL CUSTODY** or are the **SOLE PARENT**, may **ONLY** sign the waiver in front of the witness at registration check-in. (A notarized waiver signed by a single parent will not be accepted)*

*Parents or Guardians must present a valid ‘Photo ID’ at registration check-in.*

*There can be **NO Exceptions!***
